BSBF – Big Science Business Forum is a business-oriented congress which congregates the main European Research Infrastructures, focused on technology and with the aim to be the main meeting point between Research Infrastructures and industry.





















BSBF 2024 in Trieste will be the 3rd edition of the event after the success of the previous edition in Copenhagen (2018) and Granada (2022), where thousands of participants from hundreds of organizations and dozens of countries gathered together to discuss future prospects of the Big Science Market.

BSBF2026 Call

- •Open to countries, regions, cities, or consortia in Europe.
- •Bid Requirements: Program description, location details, national or local organization strength, budget and business plan, and support letter(s) from the relevant authority.
- •Deadline: June 4th, 2024.



BSBF2026 Objectives

- •Learn about business opportunities in the coming years across a wide range of technology areas.
- Meet representatives from Europe's Big Science Organizations and their key suppliers.
- Showcase their expertise and potential for the Big Science market by participating in the open exhibition area.
- Gain insights into procurement rules, intellectual property rights (IPR), technology transfer proposals, opportunities for SMEs, and how companies can interact with the Big Science market.
- Determine which organizations and projects viable innovation and business opportunities can be found that align with the company's strategy.



- •Plenary sessions, including high-level level speeches from authorities and DGs of the organizations, and topics of common and general interest.
- Parallel sessions focusing on Big Science investment in the coming years.
- Parallel sessions focusing on opportunities for companies according BSBF calls (Technology Transfer and SMEs, ABSOs and BSCM calls).
- Satellite meetings and sessions.
- 1:1 meetings (B2B and B2C).
- Exhibition spaces to showcase products and services alongside Europe's largest Big Science infrastructures.
- An SME Track and a Technology Transfer Track.
- •Networking opportunities with CEOs, Heads of R&D, etc.



The bid must also include:

- Proposals for a social program and opportunities for satellite meetings/events and site visits.
- Proposed scope, duration, and exact timing.
- Considerations regarding strategies for promotion to potential participants and potentially a media strategy.
- A list of substantiated success criteria for BSBF2026 both realistic and ambitious, and against which the performance can be measured.
- An analysis of the dates of other events, such as conferences, Big Science organization committees, or other international meetings.
- The bidder has the flexibility to propose thematic or national flavors to the event, always considering that BSBF2026 will be a mainly European event with a mainly European-wide audience.



The bid must describe the location and the city environment, and demonstrate that the location can accommodate such an event, including:

- Accessibility from all over Europe by air, rail, and road
- Hotel facilities in a variety of price ranges
- Proposed conference facilities and venues and their fit to the program
- Potential link to a big science infrastructure
- Other relevant informed deemed appropriate by the bidder



BSBF2026 rests on three financial sources:

- The selected host's contribution both in terms of human resources and financial resources to partially cover conference expenditure.
- The Big Science organizations' contribution in terms of human resources and coverage of travel and accommodation costs for their staff.
- Income from BSBF2026 in terms of registration and exhibition fees and sponsorships.

The bid must demonstrate that the proposed host allocates the required human resources (in-kind) and cash contribution (incl. outlay).

It is stressed that BSBF2026 must be organized as a non-profit event.

The bid must include documentation from the DG/CEO of the relevant authority(ies) wishing to host BSBF2026, including a confirmation that the proposed host will provide the needed outlay for expenses, commit both sufficient human and financial resources, and that the host will carry the full economic liability of BSBF2026 for any shortfalls.



BSBF2026 Evaluation criteria

- •Program quality and alignment with BSBF goals, including the proposed success criteria.
- •Suitability of dates, location, and venue(s).
- •Strength of the host organization and local support.
- •Promotion strategies to strengthen BSBF brand and media coverage.
- •The soundness of the budget and financial plan, including available resources



BSBF Trieste 2024 structure

Leader of the Italian candidature is the Autonomus Region of Friuli Venezia Giulia. To manage all BSBF activities, it has been established an ad hoc specialized structure, called **BSBF Trieste 2024** and composed of representatives of:

- · Autonomus Region of Friuli Venezia Giulia
- ILO Network Italia (CNR, ENEA, INAF, INFN)
- Area Science Park, Trieste
- PromoTurismo FVG

Moreover, the BSBF Trieste 2024 candidature is actively supported by many **Italian Ministries** (*University & Research*, *Environment & Energy*, *Foreign Affairs & International Cooperation* and *Economic Development*), the international government association *Central European Initiative* (CEI), the major national research agencies (CNR, ENEA, INAF, INFN) and many local or transborder research institutions.











BSBF Trieste 2024 overview

Focus – BSBF2024 Calls

Industry selection will also be done through a dedicated new kind of call to Big Science Common Market (BSCM call) in addition to the other traditional calls to SMEs (SMEs Track call), to spread Technology Transfer (TT Track call) and to select Affiliated Big Science Organizations (ABSOs call) already implemented in previous BSBF editions, such as the call to host BSBF next edition.

All these calls will be prepared and launched under the responsibility of BSBF Trieste 2024 and they will be published on www.BSBF2024.org website
